Dear Educator:

We are pleased to provide the **Illinois Success Sequence Program** (ISSP) for Illinois schools serving grades 6-12. A.C. Green's Game Plan, Quest, Aspire and Navigator are available for you and your students in workbook format or as an online learning course for no cost. Each workbook includes 8 lessons to supplement your class instruction. The ISSP helps students pursue academic excellence by resisting pressures toward sexual activity, alcohol, tobacco, and other drugs. Five hours of professional development training will be provided in multiple locations. The ISSP is widely used around the state serving 54,345 students in 340 Illinois schools since 2017.

Today's youth are flooded with mixed and confusing messages, particularly in the area of sexual activity. The ISSP helps you provide students with a clear message on the benefits of abstinence until marriage, which is a required component of the Illinois Instructional Mandates. Illinois Learning Standards: The ISSP is a voluntary health education curriculum supplement that aligns with the Illinois Learning Standards for Physical Development & Health and the Illinois Instructional Mandates. The program is a healthy, positive alternative for schools that choose to opt out of comprehensive sexual health education. The ISSP is a respectful, non-explicit, character-based abstinence-education program with objective messaging that is universally beneficial to all students. The ISSP includes a variety of resources including student workbooks, online learning courses available in both English and Spanish, online teacher training, supplemental videos for the classroom, and an activity box with materials for classroom activities and video demonstrations of activities.
